Things continue to develop in the meantime in our small community and we are able to continue to support the various projects. Our community is still free from Covid although very few are vaccinated as yet. Could the hot weather and living mainly outdoors be helping?

I sent photos of the grain distribution in our last report. Since then the weather has been seasonal and crops have been planted hoping for a harvest.

The severe lockdown was lifted after a month and educational institutions and businesses are back to what passes at the moment for normal. Our university students have returned to face to face tuition and our ex-student, Rammy, has sourced new laptops for the 6 new Hope beyond Form 4 students.

The academic year has shifted due to Covid and this year will end in March, starting up again with hardly a break so that it can end as normal in November 2022.

Class 8 primary pupils will be provided with lunches during the exam period in February. New students will start Form 1 in March so sponsors' photos will be late again this year.

When we visit we will be taking knickers and mooncups for the High School students so donations for those would be welcome. New underwear no larger than size 14 or bras up to size 36.

I will be writing in the next few weeks to those of you who sponsor students at the High School. I don't have any individual photos but Ayugi has got most of the sponsored students together this week and taken a group photo which I'll send to sponsors on a card with the name of your student and you can play "Spot our Student". 😊

An American friend of Ayugi has funded a well on the church compound. This will provide clean water for several families living around the church and at least a bucketful for every church attendee on Sundays.
